The application fee is a non-refundable donation of \$30.00. 100% of the fee goes to the Pike County Outreach Council. Payment is due at the time of application in order to reserve your space. The **checks should be made out to PCOC** and enclosed with your application when turned in.

The craft show is held in the old school gym located downtown by the football field (behind Tim Horton's). Crafters may begin set up at 7:30am the morning of the craft show. *Crafters will not be permitted to set up the night before.* The show will be open to the public 10:00am-4:00pm. **Crafters are NOT to begin taking down displays until 4:00pm. Crafters seen doing so will NOT be welcome back to the craft show.**
